

An **URGENT** Message for all Saddleback Residents!



We are now entering a long dry season with elevated temperatures. Vegetation is rapidly growing due to the recent rain and starting to dry out, which poses a severe combustion hazard. Please perform a survey of your property and take note of all wildfire prevention opportunities. Previously published Firewise literature and the new Placer County Hazardous Vegetation and Combustible Material Ordinance should be your guides for action to take.

If you have hazardous or combustible material (including dead trees, tall grass, dead brush, etc.) on your property that is more than 100 feet from your house, it **still may be subject to removal by the new County ordinance if deemed a hazard.**

Please remember to fill out a **HOMEOWNER FIREWISE REPORT** and record all your efforts in reducing wildfire risk, such as mowing weeds, removing dead vegetation, etc., no matter how trivial. Submit your form to the HOA in the mail kiosk drop box by August 15th, which will help towards maintaining our community Firewise Certification. Additional blank Report Forms may be downloaded from the HOA website or obtained from one of the plastic boxes at the mail kiosk.
